MRP (Material Requirements Planning) is a module that uses sales orders and forecasts, along with purchase and works orders, to create plans for what needs to be purchased and when. This helps ensure that all parts and products are available when needed.

Supplier Products



This shows the products each supplier offers and their prices. You can also see the minimum and maximum stock levels, the quantity on open orders, and how these affects current stock. It also displays the amount of stock needed to meet outstanding orders and maintain minimum stock levels.
